



The Mobile Health Clinic, operated by Riverside County Regional Medical Center, is a 40-foot-long clinic on wheels. The mobile clinic provides accessible, culturally sensitive health services to children and adults living in Riverside County, who are uninsured or who have recently lost their health insurance coverage.

The mobile health clinic is staffed by a licensed nurse practitioner, licensed vocational nurses and medical assistants working under the supervision of a physician medical director.

The mobile clinic provides drop-in care for nonemergency medical conditions. Services include healthcare education, general medical exams, preventive health screenings, vaccinations, treatment of acute illnesses and chronic health conditions such as asthma, high blood pressure and diabetes.

By providing services "on the go", the mobile clinic's dedicated healthcare professionals are helping people in Riverside County's rural and urban communities achieve and maintain better health.
